What are the places of interest?

Mussoorie, the 'Queen of Hills' is of immense scenic beauty. The emerald coloured lakes, pine forests, swift moving mountain streams, ragged rocky meadows resplendant with colourful flowers all combine to entrance the grandeur of the area and make it a fairyland. A panoramic view of the Doon valley on one side and the snow covered Himalayan range on the other make it a feast to the eye.



Shivpuri



Shivpuri is located at a distance of 90 kms from Mussoorie. It is a picturesque tourist destination, situated on the right bank of the Ganges, famous for river-rafting, kayaking and other water sports.

Bhadraj



Bhadraj offers a commanding view of the Doon Valley and Chakrata ranges. A temple dedicated to Balbhadra, brother of Shri Krishna is situated atop the hill.

Kempty Falls



Kempty Falls, located 15 kms from Mussoorie is the biggest attraction. With water cascading down from an altitude of 4,500 feet and splitting further into five cascades, Kempty Falls offers a panoramic view.

Lal Tibba



This place is highest point in Mussoorie. Lal Tibba is located in Landour area which is the oldest inhabited place in Mussoorie.

What unique products could I buy to take back home?

The main shopping centres in the city are Gandhi Chowk, the Mall, Kulri Bazaar and Landour Bazaar.

Which are some Places to worship?

Bhadraj Temple

This temple dedicated to Lord Balbhadra, brother of Shri Krishna, offers a commanding view of the Doon Valley and Chakrata ranges.

Jwalaji Temple (Benog Hill):

9 kms to the west of Mussoorie and at an altitude of 2104 meters, is the Jwalaji Temple. It is situated on the top of Benog hill and has an idol of Durga Mata in it. The temple is surrounded by thick forests and offers a panoramic view of the Himalayas, Doon Valley and Yamuna Valley.

Nag Devta Temple:

An ancient temple situated on Cart Mackenjie Road and is about 6 kms from Mussoorie. Vehicles can go right upto the spot. It provides a charming view of the Doon Valley as well as Mussoorie.
